

Students also can immerse themselves in all aspects of production through work with the Kenan Theatre Company's (KTC) student-driven main stage season. Students perform, design and manage productions directed by guests and faculty members. KTC is led by student producers choosing and managing the season. Students are supported by the mentorship of faculty members and other artists in the community at large. The DDA also houses PlayMakers Repertory Company (LORT D/AEA), allowing students to work alongside professional artists.



Our student-centered program provides a BA in Theatre with focus areas in Performance, Design and Production, Theatre Studies and a new certificate program in Musical Theatre. We also have a Theatre Education Concentration that results in NC State Licensure. Our faculty work closely with students as mentors in classroom and production settings.
