PUTTING *POLKADOTS* IN CONTEXT, THE LITTLE ROCK 9: The plot is inspired by the true story of The Little Rock 9, African-American students from Little Rock, Arkansas who integrated into Little Rock Central High School in 1957. Before 1954, schools were allowed to be “white-only” or “black-only”, based on the idea that they were “separate, but equal.” The Supreme Court case *Brown v. Board of Education* overturned this idea, and set up the basis for schools to allow black and white children to attend school together. The Little Rock 9 were set to begin school on September 4th, 1957. When they arrived at Little Rock Central High, they were met by a huge crowd of protestors. They tried to enter the school, but the Arkansas National Guard, sent by Governor Orval Faubus, blocked the doors. They were forced to turn around and go home. On September 24th, the Little Rock 9 were finally able to enter school and begin their school year. Their struggles were far from over, however. All the members of the Little Rock 9 were targeted by bullies who wanted them out of the school. Any classmates who tried to help the Little Rock 9 were bullied as well. Despite all of this, they persisted in their schoolwork and tried as hard as they could to make it through the year. In May, Ernest Green became the first black student to graduate from Little Rock Central High School. By 1968, all forms of racial segregation, including in housing, the military, and public amenities, had been outlawed.

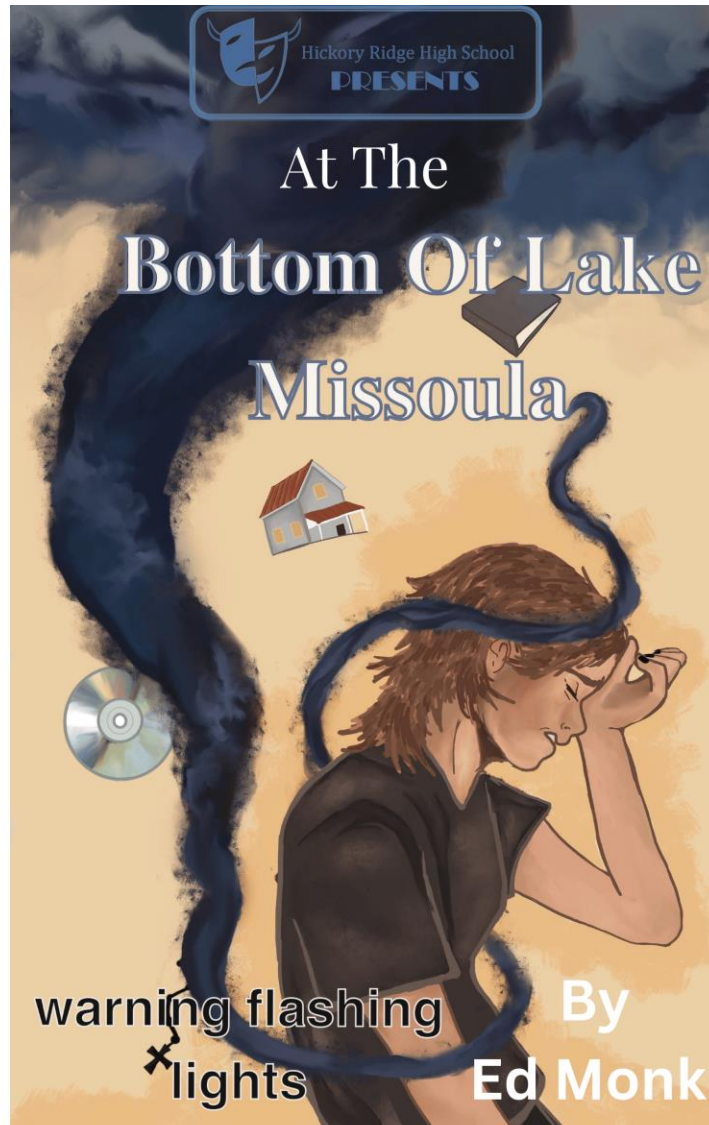

MEDEA was written by Euripides and premiered at the Festival of Dionysus in 431 BC

This production uses the Ian Johnston translation and is an original adaptation. Euripides wrote over 90 plays, *Medea* is one of only 19 plays that survived the library of Alexandria burning.

Argo: In Greek mythology the *Argo* was a ship built with the help of the gods that Jason and the Argonauts sailed from Iolcos to Colchis to retrieve the Golden Fleece.

Colchis: Colchis is known as the destination of the Argonauts. It was also described as a land rich with gold, iron, timber and honey that would export its resources mostly to ancient Hellenic city-states. Colchis likely had a diverse population.

Corinth: Corinth is the successor to an ancient city, and is a former municipality in Corinthia, Peloponnese, which is located in south-central Greece.

Hecate: Hecate was the goddess of magic and witchcraft, and so much more. Her functions extended beyond the realms of the heavens, earth, the seas, and the underworld. She was the only Titan to retain her control under Zeus' reign.

Absyrtus: Absyrtus was a Colchian prince and the younger brother of Medea. He was killed by Medea during Jason's escape with the golden fleece.

Creon: Creon is the king of Corinth and father of Glauce, whom Jason chooses to marry.

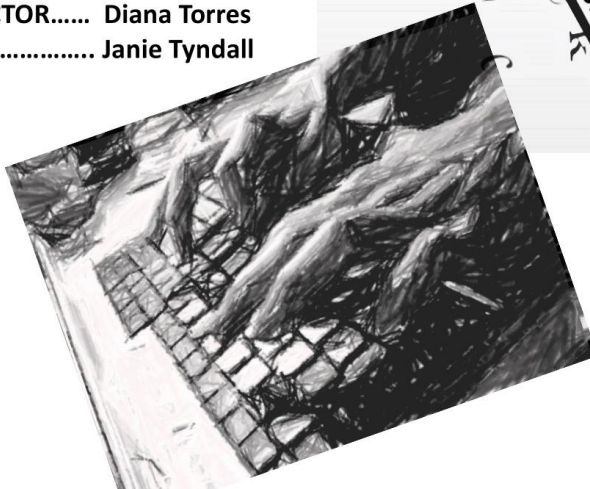
